### **Read 1 Peter 4:7-11**

Let's consider PETER for a moment. Peter seemed like a guy that always wanted to be right. Sometimes this could be embarrassing and overzealous. **Share about a time when your overzealousness for something might have caused you to do something or dive into something (purchase, etc) that you regretted later.**

Peter says in v.8 to "Maintain constant love". **How can church members "obey" this?**

V.9 - we are reminded to be hospitable without complaining. **Let's be honest...how would it make you feel if you thought the CG leaders complained every week about you coming over?**

**Why is it important to find a place to serve in and through the church** (not just some ministry elsewhere, actually serving the church family)?

[Might want to prep this before you embarrass someone] - **Ask those in your group to share where they serve and why?**

**Is it always easy to serve in these areas? Actually, what is the most difficult thing you face while serving in that area? How have you seen God be glorified through your service?**

**In a perfect world, where time and money were not obstacles, what is ONE thing you would love to DO FOR your church family?**

Spend time asking/inviting the entire group to pray right then for God to help make these "things" happen.
